## **Administrators report:**

Maria Santolupo is our new SPED teacher. She has experience in the social/emotional area. New carpet has been installed at LFW. 3 new smart boards are at Little Fireweed. Our rollover from last year was \$78,000, we thought the \$50,000 LFW rent was encumbered but it was not and came out as an expense in June. (Brandy McGee requested more details regarding this rollover and Todd will address this in his admin report at the next APC meeting) We have 112 students so far for this year. If enrollment is at 110 next year, we can get another Certified teacher

The School development plan form has been revised and is due October 1. Todd and Kim met and focused on core values, specifically constructivist learning. Todd would also like to address School Climate.

Next week we are hosting a 2-day Kagen training on Win-Win discipline and building relationship and have invited WHE staff to join. Five of our teachers attended a week long cooperative learning training last semester and over the summer break. Maria states she is following the principles of Kagan. There is a Coaching training in Feb 2018 and Todd would like to send a teacher if there is money.

Steve Shannon is our student teacher in Jon Kulhanek's class. The hiring of the Instructional Aid position is being finalized. We still have a 2hr non-instructional aid position open.

**By-Law Committee-**Crisi will send this to the APC without edits showing, from there it will go to the KPBSD district attorney, then to parents for review and comments. Then the APC can vote on them.
