Robotics on Wednesday afterschool

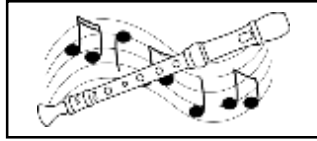
Robotic will continue this week and next week from 3:15 - 4:30. There will be no afterschool robotics the week of November 14th.
